2. A willing and joyful heart to serve

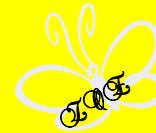

Center does, in order to use our volunteers more effectively, but much help is still needed. Volunteers could select the type of work they would like to do. We need peer counselors which work one-on-one with clients in direct ministry. Or volunteers may choose to work in the store in sales or stocking and sorting. We also need volunteers to work special events such as our golf tournament, banquet, and chocolate extravaganza. The Center is open 3 days a week, 5 hours a day. As a volunteer, you can choose to work a 1/2 day shift (of 2 1/2
