


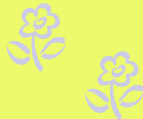

Zoe Pregnancy Center has a new address at Ninth & Friedman, across the street from Wilson Complex. This is actually the old hospital at 1235 Eighth Street and we use the back entrance and loading dock. We have taken over the basement in order to expand our services. We have expanded our Pregnancy Center to house our new ultrasound (gently used) machine, donated by Dr. Economedies in Albuquerque and also have rented a much larger space for our Thrift Store, which will allow us to further help our clients.

We are several months away from completing the necessary training and certification needed to open as a medical office offering ultrasounds to clients but have opened our facility at our new location and we would like to invite you to our **Grand Opening on April 30th & May 1st**. We are so excited about our facility we can hardly wait to show it off and thank each and every one of you, our supporters for helping us make this
